Thursday evening-- March 20---

Dear Paul----

Very glad indeed to get your good letter, which was shared by your father,-- between trains, about, returned from San Francisco and turned right 'round and left tonight for Sacramento, where he is to address a Senate Audience on Anti-Capital-Punishment-law tomorrow night,-- get back here and make a speech here Sunday evening on same subject here in Blanchard Hall to leagu working on a bill that is being pushed in this state. Next Thursday noight he is to talk on Single Tax in big Auditorium here, and a big jam is being promised, and will no doubt come true.
