Note: A copy of this sheet will be furnished to the president of the court (by the TJA) for the trial of each case. Before the court has been opened
to announce the findings and sentence the president will make the proper entries and deletions upon the form, and additions if necessary, to cause this
sheet to form a true record of the findings and sentence of the court. When the court has been opened he will then read the findings and sentence as
they appear on the form, and thereafter hand the form to the reporter or to the TJA, properly marked with the name of the accused and authenticated
with his own signature or initials, for use in preparing the record.

The reporter will return the sheet to the TJA with the completed record, and it will not be detached therefrom until the record has been signed by the
TJA and president.

If the accused is acquitted, the announcement will be made when the court is opened after the findings, the above announcement will be stricken
out (a single diagonal line will suffice), and the President will enter the word "acquitted" over his signature on this sheet before handing it to the TJA
or reporter.
